



## INTELLINET SERVICE versus PHONE LINES

### A Cost Comparison

#### SERVICE COSTS

When you add all the miscellaneous fees and charges, a typical phone line attached to a fire alarm system costs on average \$35.00 a month. Since all fire alarm systems require 2 phone lines, the average phone line costs are \$70.00 per month or \$840.00 per year. If history repeats itself, that rate will continue to rise in future years.

On the other hand, Firepro's IntelliNet service costs just \$14.95\* a month, or \$179.40\* per year, and that rate is guaranteed to remain the same for the length of your contract. \*Residential Rate with Fire Alarm Inspection Contract  
Otherwise, \$19.95 per month or \$239.40 per year.

#### SERVICE CALL COSTS

Correcting any phone line trouble can be costly, as it usually requires at least 3 different service calls. Usually the first call is completed by the fire alarm company when a panel either fails to report a scheduled test signal or reports that it has a bad phone line attached. Then the phone company is called to repair the line, and finally the fire alarm company is needed again to reconnect and certify the phone line. These service calls can together easily total several hundred dollars. There are no service call charges if a call is required to service the IntelliNet transceiver as long as it has not been tampered with. (If the service call is caused by the fire alarm system equipment, normal charges will apply.)
